



Additional Expenses/Responsibilities for Adults on Tour

Family members joining us on tour must purchase a chorale polo as well as a Spring Sing T-shirt. (\$25) We will be seeking sponsorship for the remaining T-shirts required for each day of our tour.

Adults going on tour must complete a background check through our organization. (\$10 approx)

No alcohol while on the tour

Every person on the tour will participate in **everything** planned by Gateway. If you are interested in doing some of your own activities, consider extending your trip.

Things to consider before you commit!!

-All choir members must be in good standing to participate in the tour. A chorister will be considered in good standing if he/she does not miss ANY major concerts and does not have more than 3 absences for each concert cycle. If this happens after Winter's Eve Songfest, a portion of payment may be returned. After the other concerts more severe penalties are incurred and possibly no money will be returned.

-Financial obligations must be complete.

-Haircut and color must be natural. If a change is made prior to the tour the choice will be return it to a natural state or forfeit the tour with NO money returned.

-Correct attire must be packed and with everyone on tour. If anything is forgotten, you will be required to arrange overnight FedEx what is missing to the hotel.

We will NOT offer a "tag-along" package nor will we support families who choose to organize their own trip and plan to meet us in D.C. That puts too great a burden on the tour participants and tour company.
